Ascent Construction, Inc. of Centerville, Utah, Completes Renovation of the Historic Brigham City Library

On Monday, June 21, Brigham City held an open house to show off the recent upgrades to the Historic Brigham City Library. Ascent Construction, Inc. (Ascent) recently completed a six-month restoration project of the Historic Brigham City Library built in 1898.

Construction consisted of renovation and seismic upgrades of the 20,000 SF, 100-year-old library building and included a complete seismic retrofit—sheer walls, drag struts, framing braces and epoxy coring of the outside walls to make them stronger and more rigid to withstand an earthquake.

Craftsmen construction methods and materials were used to preserve the historic look and feel of the interior and exterior of the library. The library received a complete interior remodel, replacement of the roof and reinforcement of the 30-foot chimney. With the remodel and seismic upgrades, maybe the building will serve the community for another 100 years.
